The children will be responsible for changing their Reading book from their level, whenever needed.

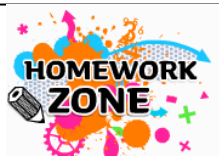
Write the date and new title each time you have a new book so that we can track the number of and types of books that you are reading.

Please do read to them a variety of texts too. Make sure you sign each time you hear them and add a comment to let us know how they are getting on.



Homework, including spellings, will be given out on Mondays and / or Friday and will be due back the following Monday or Friday, unless otherwise stated.

Home tasks are designed to build upon the learning achieved at school. The aim for parents is to encourage, support and take interest. The aim for pupils is to participate in regular practise of key skills – reading, spelling, and times tables, as well as to consolidate and practise or extend work that we have been doing in class.
