Educational visits	C, D	Provision will enable eligible pupils to benefit from the wider curriculum which boosts self-esteem; broadens life experience; and develop social skills and language. All these will support pupils to make better academic progress and increase their cultural and social capital.	£500.00
Senco salary	B, D	Senco will have time to focus on eligible pupils who have SEND to ensure that staff working with them understand their needs and implement the most effective strategies, leading to improved outcomes both social and academic.	£1,463.83
Play therapy	D	Specific eligible pupils have their emotional needs met more effectively, helping them to engage with classroom activities and thus make better progress.	£540.00
